#### First Day of School

The first day of school for all students is **Tuesday, September 8, 2020.** Cohort B students will be in-person for the first day of school while Cohorts A and C will learn remotely.

Students attending school in-person are able to enter the school at 8:20 am. The first day of school is a full day. Dismissal time for students is at 3:10pm.

## **SACC Program**

The School Age Child Care (SACC) program will be available on the first day of school in the morning and afternoon. Students registered for the SACC program can be signed into the program beginning at 6:30 am. ## **Student Screening**

Parents will be asked to complete a COVID-19 screening questionnaire using the Realtime Parent Portal to confirm students are free of COVID-19 prior to attending school in-person. More information on the screening process will be shared with you in the upcoming days.

## **Mandatory Masks**

School staff, students, and visitors are required to wear face coverings on the bus and in the school building unless doing so would inhibit the individual's health or other exceptions outlined by the NJDOE (i.e. - eating lunch).

#### Busing

#### Breakfast and Lunch Programs

The breakfast and lunch programs will be in operation on the first day of school. The costs for the 2020-2021 school year are as follows:

<sup>\*</sup> New Jersey passed a law covering the cost of all reduced meals.

If you took part in the program last year, your child will receive free or reduced breakfast/lunch until either: (1) the new forms are processed for this school year, or (2) October 20, 2020. If you do not submit a household application for free and reduced price school meals and you have not received a letter from the district informing you that you are entitled to



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free/reduced breakfast/lunch, you will be charged a full priced breakfast/lunch as of this date. Free and reduced lunch applications are available in the Realtime Parent Portal.

#### **Special Areas**

Students will receive the same special area (i.e. physical education) for a two-week period when attending school in-person. For instance, Mrs. Valenti's 4th grade homeroom students will have *art* in their classroom the week of September 8th and September 16th. Next, the students will have music for the following two weeks. The special schedule will be shared with students and families prior to the special change.

All-remote students will complete one (1) special area activity every Wednesday on the virtual day. The special area teacher will upload the assignment/activity into the grade level Google Classroom. Special area classes will rotate on a weekly basis. The all-remote instructor will update students and families of the upcoming special.

## **All-Remote Learning**

Student schedules for learning all-remote can be viewed in Realtime. Students are expected to follow the in-person schedule as outlined in Realtime **except** for specials as explained above. Below are example schedules:

## PK & K All-Remote Instruction

9:00 am – 11:30 am – PK students will follow the approved PK remote schedule (75 minutes) while Kindergarten instruction is 2.5 hours instruction.

Google Meet for morning meeting and outline of the day by the teacher

Daily shared reading with PK & K students

Daily Fundations lesson and guided reading for K students

K students will participate in math workshop that mirrors classroom instruction

### 1st & 2nd Grade All-Remote Instruction – 4 hours of Instruction

9:15 am – 10:50 am – English Language Arts Block

### 3rd, 4th, & 5th Grade All-Remote Instruction – 4 hours of Instruction

9:40 am – 11:40 am – English Language Arts Block

11:40 am - 12:20 pm - Lunch / Break

12:25 am – 1:30 pm – Mathematics Block

1:45 pm – 2:45 pm – Science / Social Studies Block

### Middle School All-Remote Learners – 4 hours of Instruction

Students will follow the in-person school schedule as detailed in Realtime.

Google Classroom will be the platform used by Folsom staff to support students in their learning. All activities, videos, and assignments will be posted in the Google Classroom. In addition, all-remote teachers have been assigned to each grade level to support students learning all-remotely. Lastly, more detail to classroom expectations will be shared with students and families by the assigned teachers once the school year begins.



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#### Water Bottles

Reminder for students to bring their own water bottles to school and to use the bottle fillers located throughout the school to minimize touching.

### **Technology Device Distribution**

The Folsom staff identified dates and times for only Cohort A students and All Remote students to pick-up Chromebooks along with specific learning materials to begin the school year. Cohort B students will receive their Chromebooks in school on Tuesday, September 8th. Chromebook distribution is necessary as the second day of school is a Wednesday all-remote day for students.

Chromebook pick-up will occur behind the school at the gym doors. The dates and times are as follows:

Thursday, September  $3^{rd}$  between 9:00 am - 3:00 pm. Friday, September  $4^{th}$  between 9:00 am - 3:00 pm.
