ELA	"IT"- Read the excerpt from "IT" by Stephen King. This is the same scene as the movie clip from the previous assignment. **It is 4 pages long, each document is one page of the excerpt. QUESTION: How does Stephen King create fear for the reader? Consider the LANGUAGE (words) he uses. Consider the SENSORY DETAIL (descriptions to help you see, hear, smell, taste, feel) he includes. IDENTIFY 2 EXAMPLES of how he creates the feeling of fear. Give the QUOTE from the excerpt and EXPLAIN how this creates the feeling of fear. Here is a model of what one example should look like. Remember you need to IDENTIFY TWO examples. You may not use the same one as in my model. MODEL: "The water made a dank hollow sound as it fell into the darkness. It was a spooky sound" (King 1). The writer uses sensory detail to describe what the water looks and sounds like as it falls. He uses the words dank and darkness which create an eerie mood as darkness is often associated with fear.
